The children had a fantastic day at Bircham Windmill yesterday. They had the opportunity to make bread, climb the windmill, meet the resident animals and play on the park! All of the children behaved brilliantly and the staff and public commented on what an asset they were to us and our school.



It has been an extremely busy start to the year, but the children have settled in well recognising the new routines and getting stuck in with their learning. They have enjoyed exploring the text 'Where the Wild Things Are' and have spent time getting to know the characters in the story, whilst using adjectives and noun phrases to add description to their written pieces. Our EYFS children have been 'getting to grips' with phonics. They have been developing their mark making skills, moving on from emergent marks to writing with a purpose. They have learnt the graphemes SATPINMD and are working hard to blend words together orally.

In Mathematics, our youngest children have been focusing on matching objects and comparing objects by size using vocabulary such as more/less, shorter/taller, bigger/smaller. Our KS1 children have started our new White Rose Maths unit and they have been focusing on 'Place Value within 20'. The children have been focusing on those numbers beyond ten, thinking about one more and one less.

Our afternoon sessions have been busy! Art has seen us focus on colour. We have used the primary colours to paint Mondrian artworks and we have mixed the colour orange to paint sunflowers in relation to Van Gogh's paintings. In Geography, the children have been exploring maps and our EYFS children created a brilliant large-scale map of Walsingham! Do pop in to take a look!

Thank you for supporting your child with reading fives times a week and with their spellings and homework – it will really make a difference to your child's education and doesn't go unnoticed!
